

Group Visit Details

* We are open to visitors from March until the 31st October from 11.00 and close at 16.30 Saturday through to Thursday. Although groups are welcome to visit when we are closed, visits for younger children are better during our open season due to the monkeys not enjoying the colder weather and not being as easy to see, plus lots of maintenance work going on (including in some of the educational areas).

* We offer a 10% discount for tour groups on standard prices. The price includes all workshops and most of the day spent with a member of our Education Team.

* We have our Café at the top of the drive and there are picnic benches in the wildlife gardens. We are able to provide covered space at our cafe for you to eat packed lunches. Children's meals are also available to buy at the cafe.

Example Itinerary

The times are approximate as we usually run with what the group are enjoying or find that we need to postpone a tour of the monkeys due to unexpected events (the monkeys do like to keep the keepers on their toes!), but we are happy to alter the itinerary according to your needs.

11:00 Welcome! *Entrance desk*

Introduction to the sanctuary

Monkey walk! *Monkey territory*

Explore the enclosures, see some of our monkeys and hear all about them from the keepers.
Ask lots of questions

12.00: Sensory Workshop *Gardens*

Explore the wildlife gardens with a monkey keeper and learn about the plants that monkeys eat and how they see the world around them.

13.00: Lunch break! *Cafe*

Chance to visit the playground

14.00: Enrichment making workshop *Front of house*

Help a keeper to make some enrichment parcels for the monkeys and see the monkeys enjoy them.

15.00: Explorers trail! *Gardens*

Visit the wildlife room.
